"NSM responded so quickly and the new ramp looks like it was made for our back-door threshold," said Marin. "Lucy and I can now go to our backyard to be in the sunshine, walk our dogs and enjoy our waterfall."

Operation FINALLY HOME and NSM will work together to assist other veterans with mobility and accessibility challenges in markets where NSM has a presence.
